

### Studio in the Woods

Main gallery: 7 July to 1 August

Studio in the Woods, founded by Piers Taylor of Mitchell Taylor Workshop, is a unique architectural workshop in which students learn and test ideas through designing and building occupiable structures at 1:1 scale.

Over the course of a long weekend each summer, the students use recently felled trees that are milled into required sections as a form of 'constructed analysis' of a place.

Now in its fifth year, Studio in the Woods has developed a cult following with students seeking ways to work with award-winning architects and teachers from the University of Cambridge and the Architectural Association, such as Peter Clegg, Ted Cullinan, and Gianni Botsford.

There is a frenetic and intense energy generated by the process of physical making in a short timescale, and a sublime beauty to the projects. This exhibition presents work from the last five years, including a purpose-made piece for this exhibition.



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
